Former GBR 420 sailor, **Emma Clark** crewed the winning boat in this year's SB3 World Championship at Torbay YC. 2009 RS 200 Nationals and Endeavour Trophy winners, Emma and her helm Geoff Carveth, together with their two other colleagues, claimed the Championship at Torbay against very stiff competition from 118 other competing boats and an [entry list](#) including several successful international and Olympic sailors, together with many familiar names from the GBR 420 Class.
