1. **PROGRAMME**

Start of RACE 5 To be announced at briefing.
(Race 4 and 5 back to back then lunch ashore.)

2. **ORGANISING AUTHORITY AND RULES**

The meeting will be organised by Bosham Sailing Club and will be governed by the current ISAF Rules, the prescriptions of the RYA Rules and the 420 Class Rules. In the event of conflict the Sailing Instructions will be available from Cobnor on the morning of the first race entered.

3. **ENTRIES**

Entries should be on an official entry form and accompanied by the entry fee.
Entries will be accepted up to half an hour before the scheduled start time of the first race entered.

4. **INSURANCE**

Every entrant shall have adequate cover against third party liability. The RYA recommends a minimum of £2,000,000.

5. **SAFETY**

Adequate personal buoyancy must be worn at all times when racing.

6. **LOCATION**

Visiting boats will be launched from Cobnor (see enclosed map) and courses will be laid in Chichester Harbour according to wind and tide conditions.

7. **SCORING**

The scoring will be the Low Points System.

8. **TIDES**

Saturday April 3 rd	HW 9.51	LW 15.31
Sunday April 4 th	HW 10.31	LW 16.09

9. **PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded according to the number of entries. The prize-giving will be at Cobnor as soon as possible after the last race.

10. **PARKING**

Cars should be parked at Cobnor and must be payed for as soon as possible after arrival. Parking in Bosham is in the car park. Cars should not be parked at the Clubhouse, on the Quay or in the Dinghy Park. If you park your car on the shore road, do remember the tide comes in!

The 420s may be parked overnight at the Cobnor car park at your own risk.

Competitors will become temporary Honorary Members of the Club for the duration of the event. Bookings for dinner at the Club and packlunch orders will be taken at registration.
