General Information

The selection series is to select teams for:

- World Championships, Hayling Island 16 25 July 2003
- Ladies World Championships, Hayling Island 16 25 July 2003
- Junior European Championships, Athens 2 8 August 2003

The selection criteria is explained within the Notice of Race for the Selector Series.

Teams are recommended by the selectors and ratified by the British 420 Class Management Committee.

All team entries shall be made only through the British 420 Class Association.

All team members will be expected to attend any team training sessions if at all possible.

2 coaches are appointed and funded by the RYA.

2 coaches are appointed by the class and funded by the British Worlds Team Sailors.

The team managers will be formally appointed by the Class Association following the final selection event. A proportion of the team managers' expenses are supported by team members.

The information that follows concerning team arrangements plus costs will help you decide on the feasibility of accepting a team place.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR WORLDS TEAM

Following the prize ceremony at the final selector there will be a team meeting.

A cheque for £680 per sailor will be requested at this meeting. Cheques should be made payable to

"GBR 420 WORLDS TEAM 2003".

This will be payable within a two week notice period.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR JUNIOR EUROPEANS TEAM

Following the prize ceremony at the final selector there will be a team meeting. The cost per sailor is £1350-00.

A cheque for £1350 per sailor will be requested at this meeting.

Cheques should be made payable to "GBR 420 EUROPEAN TEAM 2003".

This will be payable within a two week notice period.

Sailors competing at both Worlds and Junior Europeans

Please note the Class association must receive two separate cheques as they are funded from two separate accounts.

420 World Championship, Hayling Island, $16^{th} - 25^{th}$ July 2003

The British 420 Class Committee has confirmation that they will be eligible as host nation to enter a Worlds Team comprising of 14 boats and a Ladies Team comprising of 14 boats.

Accommodation

The British Team will stay at Hayling Island Sailing Club for the duration.

Team sailors must be available to start training at 9am on Wednesday 16th July.

Accommodation has been booked for all sailors commencing Tuesday 15th July and departing on Saturday 26th July.

Team managers will allocate the rooms prior to the event.

Meals

Breakfast and dinner will be provided at the sailing club.

Sailors will inform their respective team manager of supplies required for pack lunches.

World Championships, Hayling Island Cost per Sailor

We have worked out the team budget to be £680-00 per sailor.

Please note that almost all of this is fixed cost.

All places **MUST** be accepted within a two week notice period, but it would be much appreciated if sailors were able to respond immediately.

This year the RYA will subsidise the total costs of 2 coaches but are unable to offer individual sailor grants for the World Championships

420 Junior European Championship, Athens 2-8 August 2003

The British 420 Class Committee has confirmation that they will be eligible to send a Junior Europeans Team comprising of 7 boats.

The European Team will comprise

Overall Team Manager and an Assistant Team Manager

7 Teams of Under-19 sailors

British 420 Coach

Travel

Boats will be loaded for transportation at 8am on Saturday 26th July. If time permits, it

may be possible to load boats on the afternoon / early evening of Friday 25th July.

This will be done at Hayling Island Sailing Club.

Boats will leave for Athens on Saturday 26^{th} July from HISC to be carried overland to arrive in Piraeus for the evening of Wednesday 30^{th} July.

Sailors will fly to Athens on Wednesday 30th July to arrive for early evening

Sailors will fly back to the UK on Saturday 9th August.

The boats will be taken directly to Helensburgh for the UK National Championships and will arrive there by evening of Thursday 14th.

Sailors not competing at the UK nationals must inform John MacDonald as soon as possible.

Charter Boats

It may be possible to charter boats. Sailors who would prefer to take up this option rather than have their own boat travel overland must contact John MacDonald as soon as possible. Costings have been based on overland transportation and sailors wishing to charter will need to meet the charter costs.

The deadline for making the decision to charter is 11th April 2003
