420 Open Meeting



Saturday 3rd and Sunday 4th September 2005

Organised by Lochaber Yacht Club

'Competitors should note that Lochaber Yacht Club implement the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book (Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008) or at www.rya.org.uk/racing/charter

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- **1.2** The prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association will apply.
- 1.3 The Rules of the 420 Class Associations will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category C.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **3.1** The regatta is open to boats of the 420 classes.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form.
- 3.3 The entry fee is £20 per boat.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration: The Race Office will be open Sat 3rd from 09.00
- **4.2** 3 races will be scheduled for each day of the event, a discard will apply if more than 4 races are completed.
- 4.3 A briefing for all competitors will be held at 1200 on Saturday
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on

Saturday 3rd September 2005 will be 12.55

Sunday 4th September 2005 will be 10.25

5 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at Registration

7 VENUE

Racing will take place on Loch Linnhe in the vicinity of the Yacht Club.

8 THE COURSE

The course will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions and at the Briefing.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1 Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

10 SCORING

10.1 The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply.

10.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, except that if 4 or more races are completed there will be one (1) discard.

11 PRIZES will be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- (i) A boat is entirely responsible for its own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility.
- (ii) It is for the boat to decide whether it is fit to sail in the conditions in which it will find itself. By launching or going to sea, the boat confirms that it is fit for those conditions and that its crew is competent to sail and compete in them.
- (iii) The boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £2,000,000.
- (iv) Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the race and the event, and include the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer, patrol boats and beachmasters.
- (v) The provision of safety boat(s) does not relieve the boat of its responsibilities.

13 SAFETY

Personal buoyancy must be worn at all times when racing.
