## SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AMENDMENT #1

### 9 THE COURSES

9.1 Instruction 9.1 is amended to include additional courses, and a change to the method of signaling the course.

- (a) The diagrams below show the additional courses, including the order in which marks are to be passed, the side on which each mark is to be left, and the signals indicating the course to be sailed.
- (b) The use of flags to signal the course is discontinued; courses will be signaled from a board on the committee vessel.

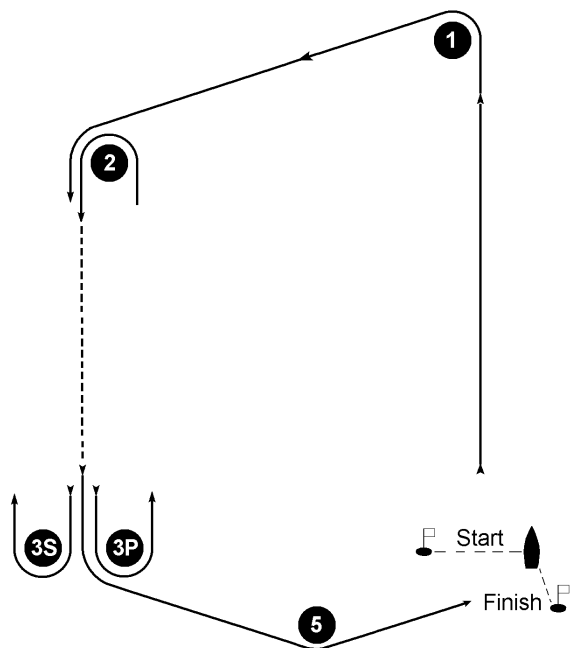
9.2 Marks 3 and 4 are shown as gates, (3S-3P) and (4S-4P), which the race committee may replace by single marks 3 and/or 4. If a single mark 3 or 4 is used, it is to be left to port. When there is a gate, boats shall sail between the gate marks from the direction of the previous mark and round either gate mark.

### 10 MARKS

10.1 Instruction 10.1 is amended to include marks 3S, 3P, and 5, which will be yellow inflatable buoys.

#### TRAPEZOID OUTER

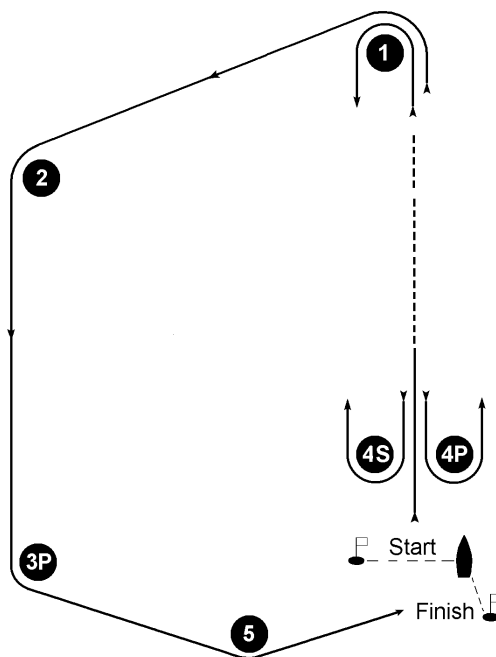

**I 1**    Start, 1, 4S/P, 1, 2, 3P, 5, Finish

**I 2**    Start, 1, 4S/P, 1, 4S/P, 1, 2, 3P, 5, Finish
