1 RULES

The racing will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

The event is open to dinghy classes including Optimist, Topper, RS Feva, Mirror, Pico, Laser 4.7, Laser Radial, Laser Standard, 420, 29er. Other classes may be accepted at the discretion of the race committee. Classes with 6 or more entries will have class starts.

Competitors in the Optimist Class shall be aged under 16 on 31 December 2005. Less experienced Optimist helms may, at the discretion of the race committee, enter in the 'red-ribbon' fleet, which may have a separate start and shorter courses than the Optimist main fleet.

All other competitors shall be aged under 19 on 31 December 2005.

Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form, and sending it, together with the entry fee, to Hayling Island Sailing Club.

Entry fees: For entries received by 22 July 2005:
Single-hander £18.00
Double-hander £32.00

Later entries, if accepted, will be subject to a surcharge of £5.00 per boat.

Parent/Guardian Declarations: All helms and crews who are under 18 years of age must submit declarations signed by their parent or guardian with their entry form or at the event registration.

3 SCHEDULE

A competitors briefing will take place on Monday 1 August at 11:00. Racing will take place from Monday to Friday (15 races) for all classes, except the Optimist Main fleet, which will race from Monday to Thursday (12 races), with a separate 3 race series on the Friday.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at the event registration. A draft version may be available in advance by download from the HISC website.

6 RIGHTS TO USE NAMES & LIKENESSES

Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.

7 SAFETY REGULATIONS

Competitors shall wear life jackets or other adequate personal buoyancy at all times while afloat. Wet suits and dry suits are not adequate personal buoyancy.

8 STATEMENT OF LIABILITY

Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility. It is for competitors to decide whether their boat and its helm and crew are fit to sail in the conditions that they might find. By launching or going to sea competitors confirm their boat is fit for those conditions and that they are competent to sail and compete in them. Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the owners and/or competitors, nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the event. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve owners and competitors of their responsibilities.

9 INSURANCE

Boats are required to be adequately insured including insurance against third party claims of at least £2m or the equivalent in other currencies.
